Job Vacancy

Holford Village Lengthsman (Village Handy Person m/f)

Following the reduction in upkeep services by the Local and County Councils your Parish Council has decided to appoint a person to look after the visual aspect of Holford Village. The person appointed will be responsible for the general cleanliness of the lanes and verges around the Parish, the trimming of obtrusive and dangerous hedge overhangs, care of the Village Green Car Park, grass cutting, road sign cleaning and general maintenance including bringing to the notice of Councillors Health and Safety issues and ensuring maintenance of equipment.

The person appointed (male or female) will have a love of the rural environment, an understanding and ability to use machinery for grass and hedge cutting, road sweeping and litter collection, be physically fit and of personable nature.

The person appointed will be paid on a self-employed basis and provide 12 days per year and 8 hours per day of time. The rate of pay will be £10.00 per hour and the time input basis will be greater in the summer months. Some training can be provided and an agreed trial period will be required. A current driving licence is required together with some experience of this type of work. Equipment and protective clothing will be provided. A local person would be preferred. The person appointed will report directly to a designated Holford Parish Councillor.
