Hi Hema,

Please find below the wording we hope, with your permission, to have fitted to the bench Christina moved to the village green.

After a chat with my brothers we completely understand that this should not be a memorial seat and we are satisfied that Christina will be properly remembered at the family grave in Holford Church yard.

We liked the wording you suggested in your last email so much I think we have more or less stuck to that:

*This coronation commemoration seat was  
rescued from disrepair in 2011 by  
Christina Taylor  
and re-located to Holford,  
a place she loved dearly*

We are hoping to have a small brass plaque fitted centre of the back wooden slat on the top of the seat so that when people are sat looking towards the green they will not be sat on the plaque. We were thinking that the refurbishment of the seat would be best left until the Spring but we could still fit the plaque with the permission of the Parish Council.

Would the Committee prefer to organise the refurbishment, (jet wash of the stone, sanding down and re-varnishing of seat), with their own maintenance people and bill us or would they prefer we make the arrangements?

I look forward to receiving final confirmation that the proposed wording is acceptable and the Council's preference for us carrying out the refurbishment and fitting of the plaque.
