### Good News.

Somerset County Council Cabinet - rethinks the decision to cuts due to extra funding received.

① Planned reductions in Gully Clearing and Jetting (£120,000) will be dropped for 2019/20.

② Also the following savings will be delayed for a year

= Flood Water Management (£80,000)

= Dementia Support in Care Homes (£100,000)

= Support to help vulnerable young people into work £50

= Provide funding to undertake a full Review of our Winter Gritting in readiness for next winter

The reinstatement of routes is not possible for this winter because we cannot ramp up operations again in such a short period of time

We are committed to review routes putting up £200,000 into gritting next year

③ The Getset service level 2 cutting this service has been delayed for another 12 months

④ update from heads of SCC. Has meet with all six councils regarding discussions on the organisation of local Government in the County
