PCSO Sue Marks is now having a drop in Youth Session at Stogursey Youth Club. This is for teenagers to attend in the warmth of the winter nights,

This is also a chance for the teenagers to talk to the police in confidence and have a safe place to stay.



At the End November, PCSO's went into Danesfield School, & delivered basic Cycle Road safety to a large number of students who are cycling to school.

It is great to see so many young people out on their bikes, so we reminded them of the need to make themselves seen by wearing appropriate clothing, riding safely & responsibly, with consideration for other road users & pedestrians.

The following day, we returned to Danesfield where we registered a large number of bikes on 'Bike Register' This is a National Scheme- which is free- to register & protect your bicycle. Over 296,000 bikes are stolen every year in this country. Bike Register is used by every Police force in the country, & reduces bike theft by up to 75%. We will be holding more Bike Marking events in the spring, so keep an eye on the Minehead & West Somerset Neighbourhood Policing Facebook Page, where we will advertise these events.
