Hi Hema

I popped down to look at the pot holes. The worst ones are where there's tarmac, or 'was' tarmac (see photo). I don't think there's much point filling these with stone, it will only get scuffed out by cars turning into the car park – but they could be as a temporary measure.

I would either suggest:

1. resurface the 5m from road edge to car park entrance in tarmac – relatively expensive but would tidy the entrance up
2. fill the pot holes with tarmac, they would need cutting out and re-tarmac
3. concrete to fill the holes
4. stone

the options fall in cost from 1 to 4. At a guess I would say no1 £2000, no2 £1000, 3 £700, 4 £300 (but total guessing and wouldn't want to spend too long finding prices on what might not even be an option)
