I will have to give my apologies for this evenings PC meeting.
At this moment my car is in the local garage with engine out in an effort to discover why the catalytic converter caused so much damage??

Just a couple of points to note;
It is expected that the Government will make a decision on the building of Small Modular Reactors this week.
Although named "small" they are still quite large, though nothing like the size of HPC.

Hinkley B. Decommissioning is set to start next year.
EdF will take responsibility for the de-fuelling, L likely to take in the region of 3.5 s 5 years. The site will then be handed over to the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority and Magnox who will complete the process.
It is now unlikely that a Fusion unit will be sited at Hinkley Point.

I assume that you have received a copy of the draft "Structural Change Order"?
As expected it contains the bare bones of how the transition will take shape. How it will work, particularly where will Parish/Town councils sit within the new unitary area, will be worked-up during the year following next year's probable election.
It is proposed that following a 2022 election, a "shadow" council will be formed to work through all processes in readiness for the new council to take charge in 2023.
